

SNOW PRINT PLASTER

For quickly casting snow impressions with minimal preparation. Extremely fast setting time without any heat produced. Works well on all types of snow with good rendering of small details.



1. Sift dry plaster powder over the surface of the impression.



2. Immediately after sifting, start mixing plaster with water in the mixing pail using a spoon. Stir until the mixture starts thickening (45 - 60 sec).



3. When the plaster starts to set, pour directly into the impression, working time approx. 30 sec. (at low temperature cover the poured plaster with newspaper).



4. The cast can be lifted after 8 – 10 minutes.

Case example

A cast from a shoe impression in one week old snow, temp. -15 degree Celsius. Individual marks in the sole correspond to details in the cast.
